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Child & Youth Study Center Discount Fee Policy

It is the policy of the Child & Youth Study Center to provide essential psychological and assessment services regardless of the client's ability to pay. Discounts are offered based upon household income and size. A sliding fee schedule is used to calculate the basic discount and is subject to update each year in February based on the federal poverty guidelines.
