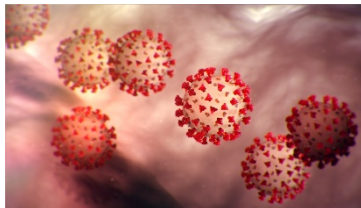

### **Situation Update:**

As of 4:00pm May 27, there have been 1,698,523 cases of COVID-19 in the United States reported to CDC, and 100,446 deaths. All **50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, and four U.S. territories are now reporting cases of COVID-19.**

Different parts of the country are seeing different levels of COVID-19 activity. CDC is working aggressively to respond to this rapidly evolving situation and is reassessing its various guidance regularly.
