COVID19 Access and Functional Needs (AFN) Cleaning Equipment and Devices

Cleaning should occur throughout the day and after using a rest room area or receiving personal care.

Use antibacterial wipes, Alcohol wipes, Clorox or Lysol wipes.

When cleaning your equipment avoid products such as spray or aerosol cleaners which may saturate the device causing damage.

Manage your own health by asking others to wash their hands.

Re: Your personal attendants: do not be shy about asking your personal attendant to assist with cleaning your devices.

You or a loved one may use some of the equipment listed below. Have you cleaned it today?

Mobility Devices:

Crutches, and Canadian Crutches: clean the hand hold areas

Walkers: clean the hand holds and seating area

Scooters: clean the control mechanism and hand holds as well as any other commonly touched area Manual Wheelchairs: clean - hand holds for those who may push the chair- self-movement hand holds

on tire area – brake locks – arm rests

Power Wheelchairs: clean - the joy stick or control box area as well as arm rests a few times a day

Communication Devices: clean these devices several times a day.

Computer and Technology: Cell Phone, Computer, I Pad, Tablets, Keyboards, Laptops, Amazon Echo Dot, Amazon Spot

Augmentative Communication Devices: NOVA chats, Tobii Dynavox, GoTalks, adapted switches, PODD books, Core Word Sheets, Laminated communication cards and Writing Aids

Hearing - Amplified Telephones, Pocketalkers, Neckloop, Telecoils, Noise Cancelling Headphones, CapTel and SonicAlerts

Vision: Hand-Held Magnifiers, Ruby HD Hand Held Magnifier, Talking Watches, LED Table Lights

Environmental Adaptations: Mounting devices, Bluetooth Switches

Personal daily living Tools:

Special Utensils or feeding/ drinking items; Many of us travel with these items in our bags. Be sure to have them in individual Ziplock bags to keep them clean for each use

Other Assisted Daily Living Tools:

Home medical devices: such as Nebulizers, C-PAP devices and Medication Management Devices Wipe down the outside of the equipment or clean these items as suggested by the manufacturer.
